

Accessibility Statement

Bratislava City Museum is committed to ensuring the accessibility of its website in accordance with Act No. 95/2019 Coll. on Information Technology in Public Administration and the relevant implementing legislation, within the scope of the requirements of Directive (EU) 2016/2102 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the accessibility of the websites and mobile applications of public sector bodies.

This accessibility statement applies to the website mmb.sk.

Compliance status

This website is partially compliant with Act No. 95/2019 Coll. on Information Technology in Public Administration and the relevant implementing legislation, within the scope of the requirements of Directive (EU) 2016/2102, due to the non-compliances listed below.

Non-accessible content

The content listed below is not accessible for the following reasons:

Non-compliance with Directive (EU) 2016/2102 on the accessibility of the websites and mobile applications of public sector bodies

1. On some pages, the semantic heading hierarchy is not correctly implemented. The main page heading may not be marked up as a level-one heading, and the heading structure may therefore fail to convey the relationships between sections of content correctly.

[Success Criterion 1.3.1 Info and Relationships]

2. The website currently does not provide a mechanism for bypassing repeated navigation blocks and moving directly to the main content of the page. This may make the website more difficult to use for people who navigate using a keyboard or assistive technologies.

[Success Criterion 2.4.1 Bypass Blocks]

3. Some published PDF documents may not be fully accessible to assistive technologies. They may lack correct structural tags, semantically defined headings and lists, correct table structure, a defined reading order, or other elements needed for proper interpretation by assistive technologies. This applies in particular to some older documents and documents provided to Bratislava City Museum by third parties.

Remediation of identified accessibility issues

Bratislava City Museum is aware of the issues listed above and is working to address them.

The technical accessibility issues listed in points 1 and 2 are planned to be resolved by 31 October 2026 at the latest. Once they have been resolved, we will reassess the accessibility of the website and update this statement.

New documents created by the museum will be prepared with accessibility requirements in mind from the outset, including when they are exported to PDF.

Existing PDF documents will be remediated gradually, with priority given to current and most frequently used documents. For documents provided by third parties, we will address accessibility to the extent that it is within our ability to do so.
